

Behaviour (These points are linked to the Behaviour Policy)

- The removal of hoodies/ headphones at start of the lesson is a must (Headphones can be used at the discretion of the teacher)
- Reinstating warning system – see below
- Violence/ aggression of staff member or pupil- contact SMT straight away and follow up with referral and / or Violence and aggression form
- PT good neighbour policy- ensuring that a PT is always available- see attached

Referrals-

- Whoever instigates referral, should close referral
- Feedback must be given on all referrals
- Actions MUST be tried by PT before passing onto SMT
- If a pupil is removed from class then an automatic referral should be put in and interval detention issued by CLASS TEACHER
- For info to PCS

3 Step System -

The 3 Step System is linked to the behaviour flow chart and many things are still the same.

For example, warnings can be given out for:

- Talking
 - Being rude/ cheeky
 - Refusing to follow instructions
 - Chewing in class if persistent
 - Phones out- if persistent
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- 3rd warning is referral and interval detention issued by class teacher
 - If first detention is missed then PT will give second chance to pupil, if missed again then automatic lunch or evening detention
 - If missed again then PT to call home and if no resolution then passed to SMT
 - If pupil is using dangerous or offensive behaviour contact SMT on duty
 - If SMT not needed and PT is teaching, PT on duty is available to contact
